

3 Steps for Cleaning Your Touch Screen

Cleaning your touch screen isn't a difficult task. You'll need **a few supplies** and these **three, simple steps**.

Supplies

1. Microfiber cloth
2. Distilled water and vinegar or commercial touch screen cleaning agent

1. Turn off the touch screen and any devices connected to it before cleaning it.

a. You minimize the risk of damage to the device.

b. You'll be able to see smudges, dirt, and debris when the screen is off.

2. Using a microfiber cloth, brush it across the screen in small, concentric circles – think "wax on, wax off."

3. If any dirt or smudges remain, dampen the cloth with a 50/50 mix of vinegar and distilled water or commercial cleaning agent.

a. Never spray the cleaner on the screen; always spray the cleaner on the cloth.

b. Never use anything paper-based since paper products can scratch the screen.

c. Regular water can be used, but distilled won't leave water spots.

BONUS TIP. Decide on a set time to clean your touch screen and stick to the schedule. Habits are easier to maintain, and your touch screen will look brand new for months to come.
